The Queensland Industrial Registrar has issued Decisions, pursuant to the Industrial Relations Act 1999, that the Electoral Commission of Queensland conduct an election for positions of office within the Salaried Doctors Queensland, Industrial Organisation of Employees.

Nominations close at 5.00 p.m. on Monday, 22 March 2010

Any financial member of the State Federation including a retiring member of State Council may nominate by signing a nomination form which shall indicate the position or positions for which the member is nominating. A financial member of the organisation must be financial starting 60 days before the opening time for nominations and ending at the closing time for nominations.

Nominations for election to State Council open on Monday, 1 March 2010 and close with the Electoral Commission of Queensland at 5.00 p.m. on Monday, 22 March 2010. All nominations must be in writing and received by the Commission before nominations close. They can be delivered by hand, post or facsimile transmission.

A nomination form suitable for use in this election is printed with this Journal. Nomination forms are also available from your Union's office, the Electoral Commission and the Commission's website; www.ecq.qld.gov.au. Any form of nomination that complies with the Union's rules is acceptable.

Candidate Statements

Nominees should lodge a statement in support of their nomination. Candidate statements are to be on a single A4 sheet of paper, printed on both sides, that includes the candidate's name and other details in support of his/her candidacy. The Commission will have these statements reproduced and distribute them with the ballot papers.

Ballot

If there are more candidates than positions for any office, the Commission will take a secret postal ballot of eligible members. A roll of voters for a State Branch is completed when nominations close and includes financial members for a period starting 60 days before nominations open and ending at the closing time for nominations. Ballot material will be posted to eligible members on Monday, 12 April 2010. The ballot will close at midday on Tuesday, 4 May 2010.

Voting is by the Preferential method; **every square must be numbered**. Candidates with the highest number of votes, after successive distribution of the preferences of the candidates with the lowest number of votes, shall be declared elected.
